

Testing is needed to curb deaths...

Massive testing helps to isolate cases and prevent spread of pandemic

Most LMICs, however, currently have very low testing rates





Testing rate





What do we want to deliver in next 12 months?




Significant number of LMICs have been supported to put in place effective test, trace, isolate strategies

 12 months


